

RESPIRATOR FIT TESTING

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS Section 25 (1)(a) of the OHS Act states that protective devices are to be provided. Section 25(1)(d) says that employers must ensure that protective devices provided are used as prescribed. Section 25(2)(a) describes the duty to provide workers with instruction to protect the safety of the worker.
