

# CSA Standards Have Changed!

**FORKLIFT SAFETY TRAINING  
UPDATE**



## 18 Month Driving Evaluations are no longer required.

As of January of 2015 a new version of the CSA standard for Forklifts has been introduced. Under the updated standard now called CSA Standard 355-15 you will notice that they have taken out the requirements for employers to conduct “mid-term evaluations” 18 months after the initial forklift training.

With that said, it has been an Ontario standard since 2004. For 11 years, employers have been doing these 18 month driving evaluations. It has become an “industry standard”. Will you continue to do these evaluations even though it is now not part of the CSA standard? Under the Ontario’s Health & Safety Act, employers are required to “Take every precaution reasonable in the circumstances for the protection of the worker”.
