

JOINT HEALTH & SAFETY COMMITTEE CERTIFICATION TRAINING PART 2 FOR CONSTRUCTION

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

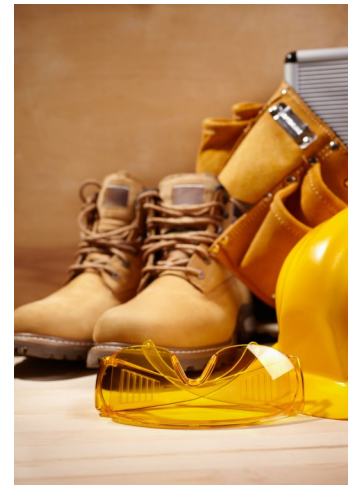
Once JHSC Members have successfully completed Basic Certification Training—Part 1, they are required to fulfill the requirements of Part 2 for Construction. The first step is to conduct a Hazard Assessment of their workplace to identify hazards within their workplace. JHSC members then receive training specific to those hazards so that they can effectively assess those identified hazards to determine if they are adequately controlled.

COURSE LENGTH: 3 Days

COURSE INCLUDES: Training Manuals, Wall Certificate, Records of Training, Attendance Report, and Application Exercises

LOCATION: Training sessions are available onsite at your facility, publically across Ontario, or our state of the art training facility. If your facility does not have access to a boardroom, IST has a mobile classroom called the Safety Bus.
