

TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS

LEGAL REQUIREMENTS: TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS ACT, 1992

The regulations require that, with few exceptions, every person engaged in the handling, offering for transport or transporting of dangerous goods be trained in the aspects of these activities that are applicable to their assigned duties. This is a self evident important concern in managing the shipments of dangerous goods. Without training, workers are not able to select the proper packaging for a consignment, or properly label and document it. Without labeling and documentation, place-carding of loads may not occur and a resulting accident caused by improper packaging will escalate into a very serious incident for responders and greatly endanger public safety generally.
