LEGAL REQUIREMENTS

Occupational Health & Safety Act S.25(2)(c),(d) & (h)

Section 32 of the Occupational Health and Safety Act imposes specific duties on employers to prepare and implement workplace violence and harassment policies and programs; conduct workplace assessments and report the results; and provide training and information for workers.

It is the duty of an employer to educate their employees of the policies and procedures of the company.
