## CRANE SAFETY RULES

The following crane safety rules must be followed while using cranes at our workplace

- 1. Only trained and authorized persons are allowed to use our cranes
- 2. Before making a lift, ask yourself "what could go wrong" and plan for that
- 3. Always perform a pre-use inspection of the crane and any rigging you may be using before use
- 4. Ensure you know the weight and center of gravity of the load as part of planning for a lift
- 5. Make sure you use the right rigging equipment for the load
- 6. To prevent a load from swinging or shocking a load, move a load slowly with smooth use of the controls, if the load starts to swing let it stop on its own
- 7. Position yourself relative to the load that will optimize load control and ease of movement and clear of the Danger Zone
- 8. Loads should be deposited on blocks to prevent damage to rigging equipment
- 9. Never leave a suspended load unattended
- 10. Do not use the crane to pull the rigging equipment free of the load
- 11. Store all rigging equipment in the appropriate location
- 12. When finished with the crane, park it in a safe location & perform a post inspection to ensure nothing was damaged during use











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
